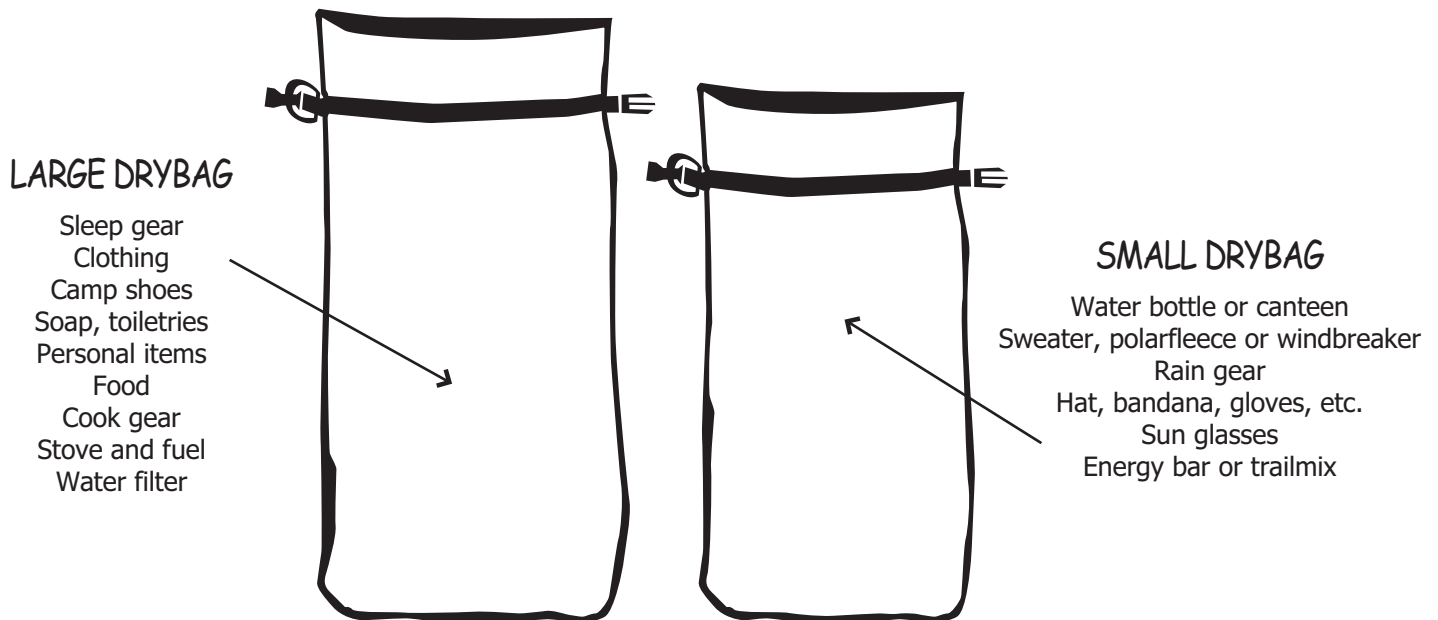


LOADING DRYBAG STUFF SACKS FOR A CANOEING OR KAYAKING TRIP



River equipment

- Canoe or kayak with paddle(s)
- Personal flotation device (PFD)
- River shoes or Teva sandals (hard sole)
- Gloves (optional)
- Rain coat or poncho; rain pants
- Hat (wide brim with strap)
- Bandanna
- Sweater, polarfleece or windbreaker
- 1-Litre water bottles (2)
- Large dry bag (36" x 12"+ diameter)
- Small dry bag

Sleeping equipment

- Sleeping bag (plastic wrapped)
- Sleep pad
- Sleep clothes (long underwear)
- Stuff sack

Clothing

- Scout uniform
- Swim suit or poly shorts
- Quick-drying long pants
- Poly shirts (2 short-sleeve)
- Poly shirt (1 long-sleeve)
- Socks (for sun protection)
- Camp shoes
- Poly undershorts

Personal needs

- Bowl, cup, spoon
- Flash light
- Rope or parachute string—25'
- Watch
- Zip-lock bags
- Pins, clips, ties
- Insect repellent
- Sun screen (waterproof 30 spf)
- Lip seal
- Sun glasses (with strap)
- Moleskin
- Nail clippers or small sissors
- Foot care (Desinex)
- Band aids
- Tri-ointment
- Medications

Toiletries

- Wash basin
- Toothbrush
- Soap (biodegradable, all uses)
- Small quick-drying towel
- Toilet paper
- Mirror
- Comb
- Shaver

Crew equipment

- Maps and compass
- Tent with stakes
- Ground cloth
- Food
- Cook kit
- Stove
- Fuel bottle
- Water bag
- Water filter
- Bear bag, rope
- First aid kit

Optional items

- Pocket knife
- Whistle with cord
- Pen & paper
- Pillow
- Matches, firestarter
- Emergency coins
- Stamps
- Emergency blanket
- Camera
- Binoculars
- Camp stool or seat pad
- Bag for shore stuff
